- Students interested in any financial aid must first apply electronically through the FAFSA website at: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/index.htm>. South Mountain Community College federal school code is 015001. This is a free service; beware of web sites requiring payment.

HOW DO I REQUEST A COPY OF MY TRANSCRIPTS?



HOW DO I ACCESS MY SMCC G-MAIL ACCOUNT?

- SMCC and the entire Maricopa Community College District now provides Google-powered email for all students. All official college communication to students will now come through these new email accounts.


The new student email addresses will consist of the student's Maricopa Enterprise ID number (MEID) @maricopa.edu. Students can start using their Google email accounts immediately, by visiting <http://www.maricopa.edu/google/>. Google also offers access to online tools that can help with schoolwork.

HOW DO I LOG INTO BLACKBOARD?

- For most courses which use the Blackboard® course management system, instructors will show students how to log-in. To log-in you will need a username/MEID. If you don't remember your username/MEID please go to this site: <https://ecourses.maricopa.edu/webapps/login/>

TEXT MESSAGING NOTIFICATION

- Effective September 30, 2009, students enrolled at any Maricopa Community College will automatically receive text messages on their cellular phones in the event of an emergency situation on their campus. To receive these messages, students simply need to provide a current cell phone number at the time of enrollment. Students not wishing to receive these messages will be able to opt out of the system.
